GENERAL INFORMATION

Meals:

- Dinner and a light breakfast will be catered by Publix Super Markets, Inc.
- Delicious snacks and treats will be available throughout the event.
- Refreshing non-alcoholic beverages will be available throughout the event.

Arrival and Departure:

- Check-in: Saturday 3:30 p.m. to 4:25 p.m.
(We can accommodate late check-in; please call 205.521.9933 by noon on Thursday, June 21.)
- Parking is available along 1st Avenue South between 14th Street and 18th Street.
- Check-in will be stationed along 1st Avenue South and 15th Street.
- Railroad Park Rangers will be available to assist families at check-in.
- Upon check-in attendees will receive wristbands and an event schedule.
- Families will set up their camping tents after checking in.
- Check-out: Sunday morning between 7:15 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.

Security and Safety:

- For every (2) children there must be (1) responsible parent/guardian.
- A parent or legal guardian must accompany their children for the duration of the event.
Children accompanied by an adult other than a parent/guardian will not be admitted.



- Railroad Park Rangers and Birmingham Police Department will be on-site to assist.
- Railroad Park closes to the public at 11:00 p.m. After this time, Family Camp-out Night participants will remain securely within the Camp-out perimeter.
- Any medications should be in an unopened container. To avoid allergic reactions, outside food and drink are not permitted, unless authorized ahead of time by the Railroad Park Foundation staff.
- Please plan to stay with your family for the duration of activities. Event schedules will be provided to plan your Camp-out experience in advance.

Not Permitted:

- Camp fire (Due to fire code, camp fires and grilling within the Park are not permitted.)
- Televisions (We strongly recommend that you do not bring electronics such as iPads/tablets, computers, and other valuables. We are not responsible for any lost and/or damaged valuables.)
- Pets
- Alcohol, tobacco products, E-cigarettes, and weapons are strictly prohibited at this private event.

Directions:

From Interstate 65 South/ Montgomery: Take I- 65 N to exit 260-B. Follow 3rd Avenue North to 14th Street. Turn right. Turn Left at the corner of 14th Street and 1st Avenue South.

From Interstate 65 North/ Huntsville: Take I-65 S to exit 259-B onto 4th Avenue South. Turn left onto 14th Street. Turn right onto 1st Avenue South.



From Interstate 59/ 20W /Gadsden: Take I-59/20 W to exit 124-A to merge onto I-65 S towards Montgomery. Take I-65 S to exit 259-B onto 4th Avenue South. Turn left onto 14th Street. Turn right onto 1st Avenue South.

From Interstate 59/20 E / Tuscaloosa: Take I-59/20 E to exit 124-A to merge onto I-65 S toward Montgomery. Take 259-B onto 4th Avenue South. Turn left on 14th Street South. Turn right onto 1st Avenue South.
