Come up close and personal with nocturnal animals visiting from the Birmingham Zoo. Have a camping lesson with tips for town or country. And as the city lights go down, gaze at the stars while enjoying s'mores and making lasting memories.

To create a family campground atmosphere, this particular event is open only to families with children. While children of all ages are welcome, this event has activities specifically designed for children between 6 and 12 years old. We hope to have similar events in the future that will be open to other groups.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Arrival and Departure:

- Check-in: Saturday 4:30 p.m. to 5:20 p.m.
 - o (We can accommodate later check-in. If needed, please call 205.521.9933 by noon Friday.)
- Designated parking is available at Baker's Row at the corner of 1st Avenue South and 14th Street.
- Check-in will be stationed along Powell Avenue and 15th Street.
- Railroad Park Rangers will be available to assist families at check-in.
- Upon check-in attendees will receive wristbands and an event schedule.
- Please set up your camping tent after checking in.
- Check-out: Sunday morning 6:30 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.

Security and Safety:

- For every (2) children there must be (1) responsible parent/guardian or adult.
- A parent or legal guardian must accompany their children for the duration of the event. Children accompanied by an adult other than a parent/guardian will not be admitted.
- Railroad Park Rangers and Birmingham Police Department will be on-site to assist as needed.
- Railroad Park closes to the public at 11:00 p.m. After this time, Family Camp-out Night participants will remain securely within the Camp-out perimeter.
- Any medications should be in an unopened container. To avoid allergic reactions, outside food and drink are not permitted, unless authorized ahead of time by the Railroad Park Foundation staff.
- Please plan to stay with your family for the duration of activities. Event schedules will be provided to plan your Camp Out experience in advance.
- Please help us keep Railroad Park clean by cleaning up around your camping area before leaving.



Meals:

- Dinner and a light breakfast will be provided by Publix.
- Menu options will try to accommodate dietary and allergy restrictions including vegetarian and nut-free.

Suggested Supply List:

(Attendees must bring their own camping equipment, INCLUDING tents.)

- Tarp (Strongly recommended)
- Camping Tent (Floor dimension 115 sq. ft. or less)

Not Permitted:

- Camp fire (Due to fire code, camp fires and grilling out within the Park are not permitted.)
- Televisions (We strongly recommend that you do not bring electronics such as iPads/tablets, computers, and other valuables. We are not responsible for any lost and/or damaged valuables.)
- Pets
- In keeping with park rules, alcohol, tobacco products, and weapons are strictly prohibited.

Directions:

From Interstate 65 South/ Montgomery: Take I- 65 N to exit 260-B. Follow 3rd Avenue North to 14th Street. Turn right. Turn Left at the corner of 14th Street and 1st Avenue South.

From Interstate 65 North/ Huntsville: Take I-65 S to exit 259-B onto 4th Avenue South. Turn left onto 14th Street. Turn left onto 1st Avenue South .

From Interstate 59/20W/Gadsden: Take I-59/20 W to exit 126-A. Follow Carraway Blvd to 1st Avenue North. Turn right onto 1st Avenue North. Turn left onto 18th Street. Turn right onto 1st Avenue South.

From Interstate 59/20 E / Tuscaloosa: Take I-59/20 E to exit 124-A to merge onto 1-65 S. Take 259B onto 4th Avenue South. Turn left on 14th Street South. Turn right onto 1st Avenue South.
