#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### Meals:

#### **Arrival and Departure:**

- Check-in: Saturday 3:30 p.m. to 4:25 p.m.
   (We can accommodate late check-in; please call 205.521.9933 by noon on Thursday, June 20.)
- Parking is available along 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue South between 14<sup>th</sup> Street and 18<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Check-in will be stationed along 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue South and 15<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Railroad Park Rangers will be available to assist families at check-in.
- Upon check-in attendees will receive wristbands and an event schedule.
- Families will set up their camping tents after checking in.
- Check-out: Sunday morning between 7:15 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.

#### **Security and Safety:**

- For every (2) children there must be (1) responsible parent/ legal guardian.
- A parent or legal guardian must accompany their children for the duration of the event. Children accompanied by an adult other than a parent/guardian will not be admitted.
- Railroad Park Rangers and Birmingham Police Department will be on-site to assist.
- Railroad Park closes to the public at 11:00 p.m. After this time, Family Camp-Out Night participants will remain securely within the campout perimeter.
- Any medications should be in an unopened container. To avoid allergic reactions, outside food and drink are not permitted, unless authorized ahead of time by the Railroad Park Foundation staff.



 Please plan to stay with your family for the duration of activities. Event schedules will be provided to plan your campout experience in advance.

- Camp fire (Due to fire code, camp fires and grilling within the Park are not permitted.)
- Televisions (We strongly recommend that you do not bring electronics such as iPads/tablets, computers, and other valuables. We are not responsible for any lost and/or damaged valuables.)
- Pets
- Alcohol, tobacco products, E-cigarettes, and weapons are strictly prohibited at this private event.

#### **Directions:**

Due to ongoing construction, your route may be affected. Please check 5920bridge.com for updated directions and detours.

From Interstate 65 South/ Montgomery: Take I- 65 N to exit 260-B. Follow 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue North to 14<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn right. Turn Left at the corner of 14<sup>th</sup> Street and 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue South.

From Interstate 65 North/ Huntsville: Take I-65 S to exit 259-B onto 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue South. Turn left onto 14<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn right onto 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue South.

From Interstate 59/ 20W /Gadsden: Take I-59/20 W to exit 126-A. Keep left to merge onto US-31 S. Take exit toward US-78, 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue-4<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Turn right onto 25<sup>th</sup> Street S. Turn left onto 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue South. Turn right onto 18<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn left on 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue South.

From Interstate 59/20 E / Tuscaloosa: Take I-59/20 E to exit 124-B to I-65 S. Take I-65 S to exit 259-B onto 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue South. Turn left onto 14<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn right onto 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue South.


